

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Community Notice

Site investigation activities Kingsford Smith Drive, Hamilton

February 2016

From late February to April 2016, Lendlease will carry out site investigations in preparation for the start of major construction activities for the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade.

These investigations include land and water survey activities.

Surveying will be undertaken on Kingsford Smith Drive and in adjacent public land between Breakfast Creek Road and Theodore Street, as well as within the Brisbane River. Refer to the map overleaf for work locations.

Out of hours activities

Due to traffic safety requirements, where survey activities are required on the road, this will be completed outside of normal construction hours **between 8pm and 5am from Sunday to Thursday.**

Where works are not required on the road, investigations will be undertaken during standard work hours from 7am-6pm, Monday to Friday, and from 8am-1pm on Saturday.

These activities are expected to have minimal impact on local residents.

Traffic conditions

A minimum of two lanes in each direction will remain open to traffic on Kingsford Smith Drive during morning and afternoon peak hours, and a minimum of one lane in each direction will remain open at all other times.

This work may be postponed due to wet weather and unforeseen circumstances and additional surveying may be required. If additional night surveying is required, we will endeavour to notify residents in advance.

What to expect

- Temporary single lane closures on eastbound and westbound lanes of Kingsford Smith Drive, between Hunt Street, Albion and Theodore Street, Hamilton to enable site surveying
- Traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists around the work areas, as required.

Our project

The Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade will widen the road from four to six lanes between Theodore Street at Eagle Farm and Cooksley Street at Hamilton. It will also include improvement works between Cooksley Street and Breakfast Creek Road at Albion.

The upgrade will increase capacity, reduce traffic congestion and improve safety for all road users.

Lendlease is committed to minimising impacts on local residents and we look forward to working with you throughout construction.
