

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Project construction update

Lendlease is continuing with service locations, geotechnical investigations and service installation activities in preparation for the start of major construction activities commencing from late May 2016.

Work is also continuing to set up the project site offices located at 605 Kingsford Smith Drive, Hamilton Community Centre, 465 Kingsford Smith Drive and the Albion Park Racecourse.

Ongoing night work

Service location and geotechnical investigations between Cooksley and Theodore Streets are continuing throughout May and June.

These activities will be undertaken on both land and in the river. The majority of works will be completed **at night between 8pm and 5am, Sunday to Thursday.**

There will also be some barge movements required at night due to tide levels on the Brisbane River.

Where works are not required on or directly adjacent to the road, investigations will be undertaken during standard work hours.

Marine construction zone

From late June 2016, a marine construction area will be in place on the Brisbane River between Bretts Wharf and Cameron Rocks Reserve, in order to start road widening activities and construction of the new RiverWalk structure.

The construction zone will be clearly marked with buoys and signage. The speed limit in the river will be lowered to six knots through this area during construction for safety reasons. Please refer to map on the back page for further information.

The public pontoon near Riverview Terrace will be closed for approximately two years, before being replaced as part of the upgrade. An alternative public pontoon is available for use at Newstead Park.

Vegetation removal

From **late May 2016**, selected tree clearing along Kingsford Smith Drive will start in preparation for major construction activities. See map on the back page for vegetation removal areas.

Site clearing activities will be undertaken in accordance with all required approvals. Fauna spotter-catchers will conduct pre-clearing surveys and be on site during clearing activities.

Due to traffic permitting requirements and to ensure the safety of motorists and construction workers, tree clearing will be required to take place **at night between 8pm and 5am, Sunday to Thursday.**

Temporary traffic changes, including temporary single lane closures on Kingsford Smith Drive, may be required, between Riverview Terrace and Racecourse Road, and between College Street and Theodore Street, Hamilton.
