

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Project construction update

March 2018

Major construction activities will continue on the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade during March 2018.

Land-based activities between Amy Street and Theodore Street will include:

- street light and traffic signal work
- investigation and installation of underground services
- major earthworks and drainage activities
- pavement construction, asphalt works and line marking
- footpath construction and landscaping
- ground improvement works
- piling for new retaining wall and signage structures
- selected tree removal in accordance with all required approvals.

Marine-based construction activities will include:

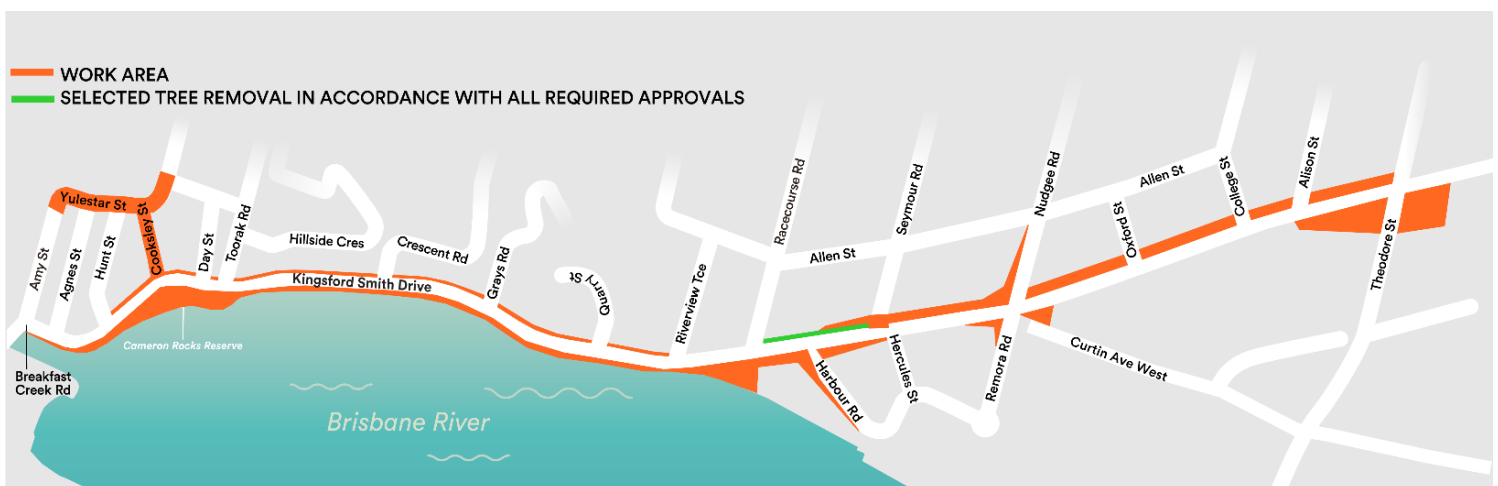
- ground improvement works
- piling for the new river walk and drainage structures
- installation of precast concrete segments and concrete pours for the main river walk structure
- concrete truck deliveries.

Work will involve:

- use of construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, compaction equipment, road saws, vacuum excavators, concrete trucks, cranes, barges, piling rigs and pumps
- noise and light associated with the use of construction equipment
- changed traffic conditions including lane, footpath and parking closures with traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required
- barge movements across the river
- night work and Sunday work as required.

Why are these works happening?

The Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade will improve the road capacity to meet the future needs of the traffic network on one of Brisbane's busiest roads.

The upgrade involves widening the road from four to six lanes between Theodore Street at Eagle Farm and Cooksley Street at Hamilton and improvement works between Cooksley Street and Breakfast Creek Road at Albion.

Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade – Current traffic changes and closures

Partial road closure – Harbour Road, Hamilton

From **Monday 19 March 2018** for up to three months, the left turn out of Harbour Road onto Kingsford Smith Drive will be temporarily closed.

During this closure, the left and right turns into Harbour Road from Kingsford Smith Drive will be maintained.

The detour for motorists travelling inbound from Harbour Road will be via the new Hercules Street connection between Harbour Road and Remora Road.

Changed traffic conditions and shared path closure – Kingsford Smith Drive, Day Street to Hunt Street

Inbound traffic on Kingsford Smith Drive between Day Street and Hunt Street has been reduced from three to two lanes. This traffic arrangement will be in place for up to 13 months.

The shared user path on the southern side of Kingsford Smith Drive between Cooksley Street and Agnes Street will also be temporarily closed to pedestrians and cyclists during this period.

The footpath on the northern side of Kingsford Smith Drive will remain open with signage in place to direct footpath users. Pedestrian access to the inbound bus stop (Kingsford Smith Drive at Cooksley Street, stop 14) will be maintained.

Extended lane closure – Cooksley Street, Albion

Cooksley Street has been reduced to one lane and closed to northbound traffic between Yulestar Street and York Street to enable major stormwater installation works. This closure will be in place until **late April 2018**.

Southbound access will be maintained and motorists can continue to use Cooksley Street to access Kingsford Smith Drive during this time. Northbound traffic that would usually use Cooksley Street is encouraged to use Toorak Road.

Cooksley Street remains open in both directions between Kingsford Smith Drive and Yulestar Street.

Temporary road closure – Seymour Road, Hamilton

Seymour Road is currently closed at Kingsford Smith Drive to traffic in both directions. This closure will be in place until **late April 2018**

Traffic is being detoured around the closure with additional signage installed to help motorists and pedestrians navigate around the work area. Pedestrian access will be maintained through the work site. Driveway access will be maintained at all times under the direction of traffic control.
