

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Project construction update

May 2018

Major construction activities will continue on the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade during May 2018.

Land-based activities between Amy Street and Theodore Street will include:

- street light work
- investigation and installation of underground services
- major earthworks and drainage activities
- pavement construction, asphalt works and line marking
- footpath construction and landscaping
- ground improvement works
- backfilling behind the marine structure
- concrete truck deliveries
- ground improvement works.

Marine-based construction activities will include:

- installation of precast concrete segments and concrete pours for the main river walk structure.


Work will involve:

- use of construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, compaction equipment, road saws, vacuum excavators, concrete trucks, cranes, barges and pumps
- noise and light associated with the use of construction equipment
- changed traffic conditions including lane, footpath and parking closures with traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required
- barge movements across the river
- night work and Sunday work as required.

Major weekend traffic changes – May 2018

As part of the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade, public utility services are being relocated and where required, replaced, to ensure these services continue to meet the needs of the local community.

Installing these underground services requires major construction activity across Kingsford Smith Drive. To reduce the impact and duration of ongoing night work on local residents, the project team will complete a number of these underground crossings over weekends in May 2018.

To complete these works, Kingsford Smith Drive will be reduced to one lane in each direction **between Grays Road and Hercules Street** on the following weekends:

- 7pm Friday 18 May to 5am Monday 21 May
- 7pm Friday 25 May to 5am Monday 28 May

Significant delays are expected and motorists are encouraged to allow additional travel time or seek alternate routes, where possible.

What can I expect?

- Works will be completed 24 hours a day, from 7pm Friday to 5am Monday, when traffic volumes on Kingsford Smith Drive are lower.
- Construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, compaction equipment, road saws, vacuum excavators, small cranes and asphalt equipment.
- Noise and lights associated with the use of construction equipment, including vehicles and equipment with flashing lights and white noise (non-tonal) reversing beepers for the safety of onsite workers.
- Changed traffic conditions, including lane and footpath closures with traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required.
- Access to local streets and private property will be maintained during these works.

Temporary lane closure – Cooksley Street

To enable major stormwater installation works, Cooksley Street will be closed between Yulestar Street and Kingsford Smith Drive on the following weekends:

- **9am Friday 11 May to 5am Monday 14 May**
- **9am Friday 18 May to 5am Monday 21 May**

During these periods, the following traffic changes will be in place:

- **Access to Kingsford Smith Drive and the Inner City Bypass (ICB) from Cooksley Street will be closed.**
- Cooksley Street will remain closed to northbound traffic between Kingsford Smith Drive and York Street.

These activities have been scheduled to take place continuously over these weekends to minimise the impact and duration of ongoing night works on the local community.

In the event of wet weather or unforeseen circumstances, this activity will occur on the next available weekend.

Why are these works happening?

The Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade will improve the capacity of the road to meet the future needs of the traffic network on one of Brisbane's busiest roads.

The upgrade involves widening the road from four to six lanes between Theodore Street at Eagle Farm and Cooksley Street at Hamilton. It also includes improvement works between Cooksley Street and Breakfast Creek Road at Albion.

Cooksley Street northbound lane reopening

From **late-May 2018**, the northbound lane on Cooksley Street between Yulestar Street and York Street will reopen to traffic.

The eastbound lane on Yulestar Street between Hunt Street and Cooksley Street will remain closed until **late-June 2018**.

In the event of wet weather or unforeseen circumstances, these activities may be extended.
