

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Project construction update

June 2018

Major construction activities will continue on the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade during June 2018.

Land-based activities between Amy Street and Theodore Street will include:

- street light work
- investigation and installation of underground services
- major earthworks
- drainage activities
- pavement construction, asphalt works and line marking
- footpath construction
- landscaping
- ground improvement works
- backfilling behind the marine structure
- concrete truck deliveries.

Marine-based construction activities will include:

- installation of precast concrete segments
- concrete pours for the main river walk structure.


Work will involve:

- use of construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, compaction equipment, road saws, vacuum excavators, concrete trucks, cranes, barges and pumps
- noise and light associated with the use of construction equipment
- changed traffic conditions including lane, footpath and parking closures with traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required
- barge movements across the river
- night work and Sunday work as required.

Major weekend traffic changes – June/July 2018

To enable underground service and stormwater installation works, major construction activities across Kingsford Smith Drive are required.

To reduce the impact and duration of ongoing night work on local residents, the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade team will complete a number of these activities over weekends in June and July 2018.

To complete these works, Kingsford Smith Drive will be reduced to one lane in each direction **between Cooksley Street, Albion and Oxford Street, Hamilton** (see map overleaf) on the following weekends in June and July:

- 7pm Friday 8 June to 5am Monday 11 June
- 7pm Friday 15 June to 5am Monday 18 June
- 7pm Friday 22 June to 5am Monday 25 June
- 7pm Friday 29 June to 5am Monday 2 July
- 7pm Friday 6 July to 5am Monday 9 July
- 7pm Friday 20 July to 5am Monday 23 July
- 7pm Friday 27 July to 5am Monday 30 July.

Significant delays are expected and motorists are encouraged to allow additional travel time or seek alternate routes, where possible.

What can I expect?

- Works will be completed 24 hours a day, from 7pm Friday to 5am Monday, when traffic volumes on Kingsford Smith Drive are lower.
- Construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, compaction equipment, road saws, vacuum excavators, small cranes and asphalt equipment.
- Noise and lights associated with the use of construction equipment, including vehicles and equipment with flashing lights and white noise (non-tonal) reversing beepers for the safety of onsite workers.
- Changed traffic conditions, including lane and footpath closures with traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required.
- Access to local streets and private property will be maintained during these works.

Why are these works happening?

The Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade will improve the capacity of the road to meet the future needs of the traffic network on one of Brisbane's busiest roads.

The upgrade involves widening the road from four to six lanes between Theodore Street at Eagle Farm and Cooksley Street at Hamilton. It also includes improvement works between Cooksley Street and Breakfast Creek Road at Albion.

Temporary road closures – Cooksley Street, Albion

To enable major stormwater installation works, Cooksley Street will be closed between Yulestar Street and Kingsford Smith Drive on the following weekends:

- **9am Friday 1 June to 5am Monday 4 June**
- **9am Friday 15 June to 5am Monday 18 June**
- **9am Friday 22 June to 5am Monday 25 June**

During these periods, the following traffic changes will be in place:

- **access to Kingsford Smith Drive and the Inner City Bypass (ICB) from Cooksley Street will be closed**
- Cooksley Street will remain closed to northbound traffic between Kingsford Smith Drive and York Street.

The Cooksley Street entrance to the Hamilton BP service station will be closed over these weekends. Motorists wishing to access the Hamilton BP can continue to do so from Kingsford Smith Drive. Access to the Cooksley Street entrance of the Kingsford Riverside Inn will be maintained under traffic control.

Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to direct all motorists.

A detour route will be in place for all traffic movements during these closures:

- access to the ICB and Breakfast Creek Road will be via Crosby Road
- access to Kingsford Smith Drive heading east will be via Toorak Road
- access to the northern end of Cooksley Street will be via Toorak Road.

These activities have been scheduled to take place continuously over three weekends to minimise the impact and duration of ongoing night works on the local community.

In the event of wet weather or unforeseen circumstances, this activity will occur on the next available weekend.
