

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Project construction update

September 2018

Major construction activities will continue on the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade during September 2018.

Land-based activities between Amy Street and Theodore Street will include:

- street light work
- investigation and installation of underground services
- major earthworks
- drainage activities
- pavement construction, asphalt works and line marking
- footpath, kerb and driveway construction
- landscaping
- ground improvement works
- backfilling behind the river walk structure
- concrete truck deliveries
- selected tree removal in accordance with all required approvals.


Work will involve:

- use of construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, compaction equipment, road saws, vacuum excavators, concrete trucks, cranes, asphalt pavers and pumps
- noise and light associated with the use of construction equipment
- changed traffic conditions including lane, footpath and parking closures with traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required.

Upcoming traffic changes

Changed traffic and pedestrian conditions – Racecourse Road to Seymour Road

Works will begin in **late September 2018** to upgrade the northern side of Kingsford Smith Drive between Racecourse Road and Seymour Road, Hamilton, and are expected to continue for approximately 12 months.

To accommodate these works, vehicles will be moved onto the newly-constructed southern lanes of Kingsford Smith Drive.

Additional signage will be installed to help motorists and pedestrians navigate through the work area.

Temporary road closure – Woonah Avenue, Eagle Farm

From **Thursday 27 September 2018 for up to four months**, Woonah Avenue will be closed at Kingsford Smith Drive to traffic in both directions.

This closure is required to allow for the installation of stormwater infrastructure and new underground services, and construction of the new road pavement.

Access to the TAFE will be via a temporary driveway through the TAFE from Kingsford Smith Drive.

Why are these works happening?

The Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade will improve the capacity of the road to meet the future needs of the traffic network on one of Brisbane's busiest roads.

The upgrade involves widening the road from four to six lanes between Theodore Street at Eagle Farm and Cooksley Street at Hamilton. It also includes improvement works between Cooksley Street and Breakfast Creek Road at Albion.

Major weekend traffic changes – September and October 2018

To enable underground service and stormwater installation works, major construction activities across Kingsford Smith Drive are required.

To reduce the impact and duration of ongoing night work on local residents, the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade team will complete a number of these activities over weekends in September and October 2018.

To complete these works, Kingsford Smith Drive will be reduced to one lane in each direction **between Crescent Road, Hamilton and Theodore Street, Hamilton** (see map overleaf) on the following weekends in September and October:

- 7pm Friday 7 September to 5am Monday 10 September
- 7pm Friday 14 September to 5am Monday 17 September
- 7pm Friday 21 September to 5am Monday 24 September
- 7pm Friday 5 October to 5am Monday 8 October.

Significant delays are expected and motorists are encouraged to allow additional travel time or seek alternate routes, where possible.

What can I expect?

- Works will be completed 24 hours a day, from 7pm Friday to 5am Monday, when traffic volumes on Kingsford Smith Drive are lower.
- Construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, compaction equipment, road saws, vacuum excavators, small cranes and asphalt equipment.
- Noise and lights associated with the use of construction equipment, including vehicles and equipment with flashing lights and white noise (non-tonal) reversing beepers for the safety of onsite workers.
- Changed traffic conditions, including lane and footpath closures with traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required.
- Access to local streets and private property will be maintained during these works.
