

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Project construction update

October 2018

Major construction activities will continue on the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade during October 2018.

Land-based activities between Amy Street and Theodore Street will include:

- street light work
- investigation and installation of underground services
- major earthworks
- drainage activities
- pavement construction, asphalt works and line marking
- footpath, kerb and driveway construction
- landscaping
- ground improvement works
- backfilling behind the river walk structure
- concrete truck deliveries
- landscaping activities.

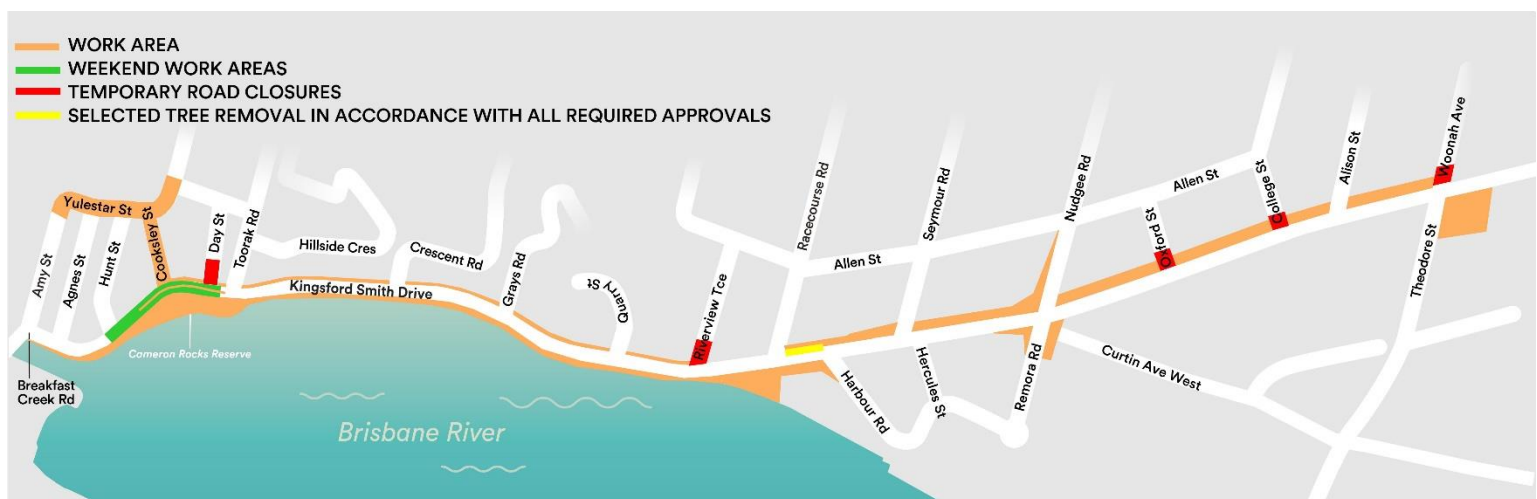
Work will involve:

- use of construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, compaction equipment, road saws, vacuum excavators, concrete trucks, cranes, asphalt pavers and pumps
- noise and light associated with the use of construction equipment
- changed traffic conditions including lane, footpath and parking closures with traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required.

Upcoming pedestrian and traffic changes

Temporary road closure – College Street, Hamilton

From **3 October for up to three months**, College Street will be closed at Kingsford Smith Drive to traffic in both directions.

Traffic will be detoured around the closure via the reopened Alison Street with additional signage installed to help motorists and pedestrians navigate around the work area.

Pedestrian access will be maintained through the work site. Driveway access will be maintained at all times under the direction of traffic control if required.

Changed traffic conditions – Cooksley Street, Albion

From **mid-October for approximately six weeks**, works will be undertaken to upgrade the verges and pavement along Cooksley Street, between Yulestar Street and Kingsford Smith Drive.

To accommodate these works, the traffic barriers currently on the western side of Cooksley Street will be moved to the eastern side of Cooksley Street, adjacent to the Hamilton BP.

Access to Kingsford Smith Drive from Cooksley Street will remain via one lane, which will allow both left and right-hand traffic movements out of Cooksley Street onto Kingsford Smith Drive. Access to Cooksley Street from Kingsford Smith Drive will remain open to both inbound and outbound traffic.

Changed traffic conditions – Agnes Street to Toorak Road, Hamilton

From **late October**, works will begin to upgrade the median of Kingsford Smith Drive between Hunt Street and Toorak Road, and are expected to continue for **approximately four months**.

To accommodate these works, temporary traffic barriers will be installed in the centre of Kingsford Smith Drive between Hunt Street and Cooksley Street and between Cooksley Street and Toorak Road. This will enable the majority of these works to be undertaken during standard construction hours.

Major weekend traffic changes – October 2018

To enable completion of pavement works, major construction activities across Kingsford Smith Drive are required.

To reduce the impact and duration of ongoing night work on local residents, the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade team will complete a number of these activities over a weekend in October 2018.

To complete these works, Kingsford Smith Drive will be reduced to one lane in each direction **between Hunt Street and Toorak Road, Hamilton** (see map overleaf) from **7pm Friday 26 October to 5am Monday 29 October**.

Motorists are encouraged to allow additional travel time or seek alternate routes, where possible.

What can I expect?

- Works will be completed 24 hours a day, from 7pm Friday to 5am Monday, when traffic volumes on Kingsford Smith Drive are lower.
- Construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, compaction equipment, road saws, vacuum excavators, small cranes and asphalt equipment.
- Noise and lights associated with the use of construction equipment, including vehicles and equipment with flashing lights and white noise (non-tonal) reversing beepers for the safety of onsite workers.
- Changed traffic conditions, including lane and footpath closures with traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required.
- Access to local streets and private property will be maintained during these works.

Why are these works happening?

The Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade will improve the capacity of the road to meet the future needs of the traffic network on one of Brisbane's busiest roads.

The upgrade involves widening the road from four to six lanes between Theodore Street at Eagle Farm and Cooksley Street at Hamilton. It also includes improvement works between Cooksley Street and Breakfast Creek Road at Albion.
