

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Project construction update

November 2018

Major construction activities will continue on the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade during November 2018.

Land-based activities between Amy Street and Theodore Street will include:

- street light work
- investigation and installation of utility services
- major earthworks
- drainage activities
- pavement construction, asphalt works and line marking
- footpath, kerb and driveway construction
- ground improvement works
- backfilling behind the river walk structure
- concrete truck deliveries
- landscaping activities
- selected tree removal in accordance with all required approvals.


Work will involve:

- use of construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, road saws, vacuum excavators, concrete trucks, cranes, pumps and asphalt and compaction equipment.
- noise and light associated with the use of construction equipment
- changed traffic conditions including lane, footpath and parking closures with traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required.

Upcoming pedestrian and traffic changes

Temporary lane closure – Cooksley Street, Albion

On **Saturday 3 and Sunday 4 November 2018 between 7am and 5pm**, Cooksley Street will be reduced to one lane between Yulestar Street and Kingsford Smith Drive to enable stormwater installation works.

During this period, **southbound access to Kingsford Smith Drive and the Inner City Bypass (ICB) will be closed**. Northbound access to Cooksley Street from Kingsford Smith Drive will remain open under traffic control. Additional signage will be in place to direct motorists around the works area.

Temporary road closure – Cooksley Street, Albion

From **9am Friday 9 November to 5am Monday 11 November 2018**, Cooksley Street will be closed to traffic between York Street and Kingsford Smith Drive to enable final pavement works. Yulestar Street will also be closed to traffic between Hunt Street and Cooksley Street during this period.

Throughout these works, the following traffic changes will be in place:

- Access to Kingsford Smith Drive and the Inner City Bypass (ICB) from Cooksley Street will be closed.
- Access to Yulestar Street from Cooksley Street will be closed.

Why are these works happening?

The Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade will improve the capacity of the road to meet the future needs of the traffic network on one of Brisbane's busiest roads.

The upgrade involves widening the road from four to six lanes between Theodore Street at Eagle Farm and Cooksley Street at Hamilton. It also includes improvement works between Cooksley Street and Breakfast Creek Road at Albion.

Completion of Yulestar and Cooksley Street improvement activities

From **late-November 2018**, final line marking will be installed on Yulestar and Cooksley Streets following the completion of improvement activities.

These works included the widening of Yulestar Street to accommodate new on-street parking and widened footpaths, and changing the intersection of Yulestar and Cooksley Streets to give priority to vehicles turning right into and left out of Yulestar Street.

Activities completed in this area also included major drainage installation, traffic signal works and pavement upgrades.

Upcoming changed traffic conditions – Seymour Road to Theodore Street

In **December 2018**, outbound traffic will be moved to the newly-constructed northern lanes of Kingsford Smith Drive between Seymour Road and Theodore Street.

Inbound traffic will remain on the existing southern lanes.

These changed traffic conditions will allow construction activities to commence in the centre of Kingsford Smith Drive east of Seymour Road, including centre median construction, landscaping and finishing works.
