Permanent closure – right turn into Amy Street, Albion

May 2017

From Tuesday 16 May, the right turn into Amy Street, Albion from Kingsford Smith Drive will permanently close. Access to Amy Street will be available via Cooksley Street and Yulestar Street.

The right turn closure into Amy Street is required to create space for a second inbound lane on Amy Street onto Breakfast Creek Road to improve traffic flow in the local area.

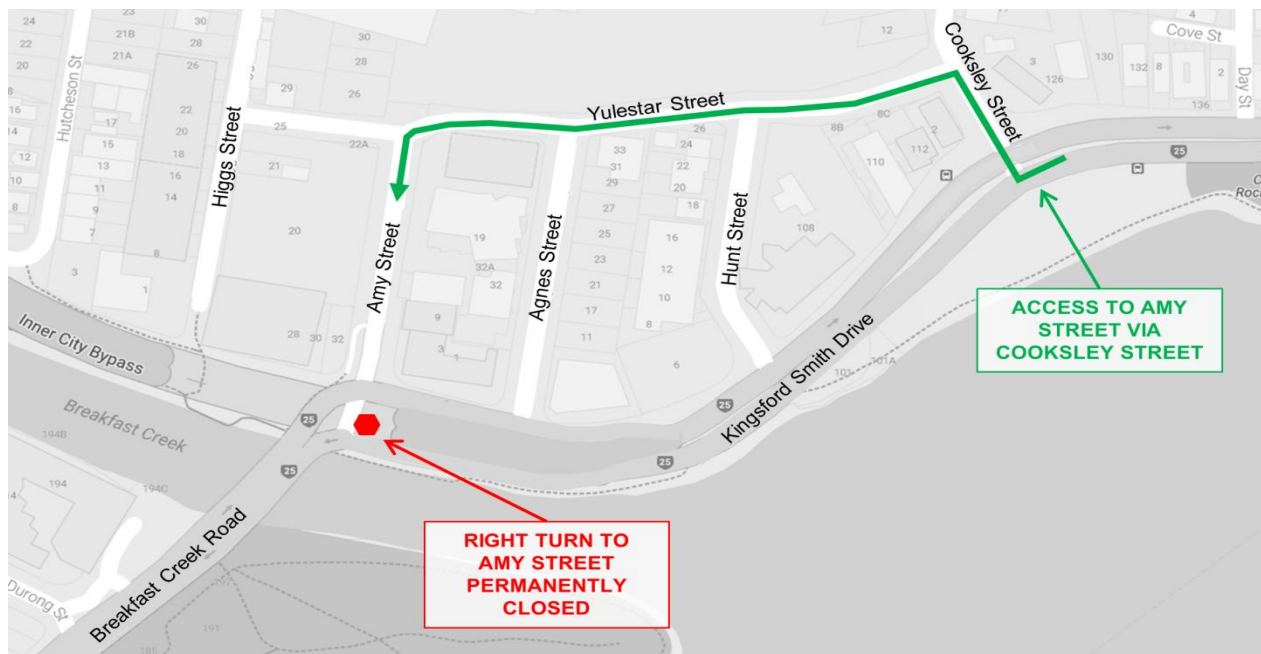
Due to traffic permit restrictions, work to implement this traffic change will take place at night, from 8pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday nights.

The work will involve changes to the existing traffic signals, median, profiling and asphalt works. This work is expected to take approximately four weeks, weather permitting.

Local residents may see and hear these works.

What to expect

- Use of equipment such as small cranes, road saws, excavators, asphalt and compaction equipment, concrete trucks and lighting towers
- Truck movements to deliver materials and equipment to and from site
- Noise and lighting associated with use of construction equipment
- Vehicles and equipment with flashing lights and white noise (non-tonal) reversing beepers for the safety of onsite workers
- Traffic control and signage to direct motorists around the work areas, as required
- Operation of the laydown facility on Yulestar Street at night.
