Site office at Cameron Rocks Reserve

Lendlease is establishing a site office at Cameron Rocks Reserve, Hamilton, to facilitate construction of the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade.

Site establishment activities

From **Wednesday 20 July 2016**, site preparation will start, including construction of the site entrance and laydown areas and delivery of demountable buildings.

Site establishment will take approximately six weeks to complete. Once established, the site office will remain in place for the duration of construction.

Cameron Rocks Reserve will be partially closed from 20 July 2016 and fully closed from early August 2016 until the upgrade is complete in 2019.

Pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained adjacent to Kingsford Smith Drive. Please see map overleaf.

What to expect during site establishment

- Use of equipment such as excavators, vacuum excavators (sucker truck), trucks, graders, rollers and cranes
- Removal of selected trees in accordance with all required approvals.
- Truck movements to deliver equipment and materials to site.
- Noise associated with use of equipment during site construction.

We will make every effort to minimise work impacts by:

- ensuring all workforce park in dedicated parking areas and not on local streets
- turning off machinery when not in use
- using white noise reversing beepers on all machinery
- using dust mitigation strategies such as watering the site as necessary.

To accommodate the temporary site office and final design of the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade, public access to the car park will permanently close from 20 July 2016.

Construction hours

Site establishment work will take place from 7am-6pm, Monday to Friday and from 8am-1pm on Saturday.

Due to traffic permit requirements, some work will be required to take place at night **between 8pm and 5am**, **Sunday to Friday**. If any out-of-hours work is required, Lendlease will directly notify residents in the vicinity of the works.

Temporary relocation of war memorial

As part of these works, the war memorial will be temporarily removed from the existing location and securely stored, in consultation with the local RSL.

The memorial will be returned to the area prior to 25 April 2017 and will be accessible for the annual Anzac Day services throughout the project and for Remembrance Day services from 2017 onwards. Outside of these times, Cameron Rocks Reserve will remain closed until works on the upgrade are complete.

Vegetation removal

Some trees will need to be removed in Cameron Rocks Reserve to accommodate the upgraded Kingsford Smith Drive and refurbished park with the relocated war memorial. Please see map overleaf.

Site clearing activities will be undertaken in accordance with all required approvals. Fauna spotter-catchers will conduct pre-clearing surveys and be on site during clearing activities.

Site facilities at Cameron Rocks Reserve

The site office will include a number of demountable buildings for project staff, toilets and lunch room facilities as well as an area for workforce parking. Please see map overleaf.

Access to the site office will be via Kingsford Smith Drive. Upon completion of the upgrade, the site office will be removed and the impacted area reinstated.
