

# KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

## Project construction update

**Major construction activities will continue on the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade during December 2018 and January 2019.**

Land-based activities between Amy Street and Theodore Street will include:

- street light work
- investigation and installation of utility services
- major earthworks
- drainage activities
- pavement construction, asphalt works and line marking
- footpath, kerb and driveway construction
- ground improvement works
- backfilling behind the river walk structure
- concrete truck deliveries
- landscaping activities
- precast concrete panel installation.

Work will involve:

- use of construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, road saws, vacuum excavators, concrete trucks, cranes, pumps and asphalt and compaction equipment


- noise and light associated with the use of construction equipment
- changed traffic conditions including lane, footpath and parking closures with traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required
- night work and Sunday work as required.

### River Walk opening prior to Christmas

The new 1.2 kilometre River Walk between Cooksley Street and Racecourse Road will open to cyclists and pedestrians before Christmas this year.

Access to the River Walk will also be available near Crescent Road.

The new River Walk will allow local residents to again access the southern side of Kingsford Smith Drive, providing separated pedestrian and cycle paths as well as rest stops with viewing platforms.

## Changed traffic conditions

### Seymour Road to Alison Street, Hamilton

On **Monday 17 December 2018**, the project will move into the final stage of construction on Kingsford Smith Drive between Seymour Road and Alison Street, Hamilton.

To accommodate this stage, eastbound vehicles will be realigned onto the newly-constructed northern lanes, and the new northern footpath will open to pedestrians and cyclists between Seymour Road and Alison Street.

From **January 2019**, construction will start in the centre median of Kingsford Smith Drive, east of Seymour Road. This final stage of works will take **approximately four months**, and will involve construction of the new centre median, landscaping, some underground service installation, and final asphaltting and line marking.

During this stage, works to complete service installation on some local side streets will continue.

### Oxford Street

On **Monday 17 December 2018**, Oxford Street will reopen to traffic in both directions.

### College Street

On **Monday 17 December 2018**, College Street will reopen to traffic in both directions, and a temporary right turn from Kingsford Smith Drive into College Street be opened for **up to three months**.

### Alison Street

On **Sunday 13 January 2019**, the right turn from Kingsford Smith Drive into Alison Street will temporarily close for **up to two months** to facilitate construction of the new road pavement in the centre median. Traffic will be detoured via the temporary right turn into College Street from Kingsford Smith Drive.

### Temporary road closure – Toorak Road, Hamilton

To enable major stormwater, water main and electrical installation works, Toorak Road will be closed to all traffic at the intersection of Kingsford Smith Drive from **mid-January 2019** for **approximately three months**.

A detour route will be in place via Cooksley Street during this closure period and pedestrian access will be maintained.

### Woonah Avenue

Woonah Avenue will remain closed to traffic in both directions for the **first half of 2019**.

## Christmas closure

The project will shut down on **Friday 21 December 2018** and restart on **Monday 7 January 2019**.

During the closure, a crew will be available to perform emergency maintenance if required.

As lane widths have been reduced and sight lines impacted by barriers, the lowered speed limits will remain in place during this period for the safety of motorists.

## Changed pedestrian conditions

### Portside Wharf boardwalk, Hamilton

From **Tuesday 8 January 2019** for up to **two months**, access to Kingsford Smith Drive and the Bretts Wharf ferry terminal from the Portside Wharf boardwalk will be temporarily closed.

This closure is required to complete ground improvement activities and works on the new River Walk structure at Bretts Wharf. Access to the Bretts Wharf ferry terminal will remain open via Kingsford Smith Drive only.
