

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Project construction update

July 2017

During July 2017, the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade will continue major construction activities.

Land-based activities between Amy Street and Theodore Street will include:

- street light and traffic signal work
- road widening and drainage activities on Cooksley Street and Yulestar Street
- gas main installation on Seymour Road and Allen Street
- service location and installation works
- major earthworks and drainage installation
- pavement construction
- asphalt works and line marking
- selected vegetation clearing in accordance with all required approvals
- relocation of concrete traffic barriers.

Marine-based construction activities will include:

- installation of scour protection devices
- excavation of the existing river bank retaining wall
- ground improvement works
- piling for the new river walk structure
- production and installation of precast concrete segments that will be used in the river walk structure
- concrete truck deliveries to Bretts Wharf and Cameron Rocks Reserve
- construction of the main retaining wall structure.

What to expect

Work will involve:

- use of construction equipment including excavators, trucks, compaction equipment, road saws, vacuum excavators, concrete trucks, small cranes, barges, piling rigs and pumps
- noise associated with the use of construction equipment
- light associated with the use of temporary lighting towers
- ongoing light and heavy vehicle movements on Kingsford Smith Drive, at Bretts Wharf and Cameron Rocks Reserve associated with construction activities
- vehicles and equipment with flashing lights and white noise (non-tonal) reversing beepers for the safety of onsite workers
- changed traffic conditions including lane, footpath and parking closures, as required
- traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required
- ongoing barge movements across the river.

Work on Sunday

Lendlease will continue to undertake construction activities to install new underground services between 7am Sunday and 5am Monday over a number of consecutive weekends between late July and September 2017.

The additional Sunday shifts will reduce the impact of night work on local residents by allowing the project team to complete construction activities during the day that would otherwise need to be carried out at night.

During this work, traffic control will be in place on Kingsford Smith Drive and local roads as required, with one lane open to traffic in each direction. Access to local streets and properties will be maintained with traffic controllers at all times.

In preparation for these works, some temporary service outages may be required. Impacted properties will be notified of any service outage prior to works commencing.

In the event of wet weather these works will be postponed to the next available date.

Temporary closure of Cooksley Street, Albion

As part of improvement works between Cooksley Street and Breakfast Creek Road at Albion, major stormwater relocation work is required on Cooksley Street.

To facilitate these works, Cooksley Street will be closed from 7pm Friday to 5am Monday between Yulestar Street and York Street over two weekends in August 2017.

Due to traffic permit requirements, some work must take place at night **between 7pm and 5am, Sunday to Thursday.**

Wherever possible, the noisiest works will be completed early in the shift to minimise impacts on the community.
