

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Project construction update

June 2017

During June 2017, the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade will continue major construction activities.

Land-based activities between Amy Street and Theodore Street will include:

- street light and traffic signal work
- road widening and drainage activities on Cooksley Street and Yulestar Street
- service location and installation works
- major earthworks and drainage installation
- pavement construction
- asphalt works and line marking
- selected tree removal in accordance with all required approvals
- relocation of concrete traffic barriers.

Marine-based construction activities will include:

- installation of scour protection devices
- excavation of the existing river bank retaining wall
- ground improvement works
- piling for the new river walk structure
- production and installation of precast concrete segments that will be used in the river walk structure
- increased concrete truck deliveries to Bretts Wharf and Cameron Rocks Reserve
- construction of the main retaining wall structure.

What to expect

Work will involve:

- use of construction equipment including excavators, trucks, compaction equipment, road saws, vacuum excavators, concrete trucks, small cranes, barges, piling rigs, pumps and lighting towers
- noise associated with the use of construction equipment
- increased light and heavy vehicle movements associated with construction activities
- vehicles and equipment with flashing lights and white noise (non-tonal) reversing beepers for the safety of onsite workers
- changed traffic conditions including lane, footpath and parking closures, as required
- traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required
- increased truck movements on Kingsford Smith Drive, at Bretts Wharf and Cameron Rocks Reserve
- increased barge movements across the river.

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Temporary closure of Seymour Road and Allen Street

Temporary road closures on Allen Street and Seymour Road will be ongoing throughout June and July as new underground services are installed in the area.

Local businesses, residents and motorists will be notified via additional signs prior to any road closures.

Pedestrian access will be maintained through the work site and driveway access will be maintained at all times under the direction of traffic control officers.

Nudgee Road night work

A large number of underground services around the Nudgee Road, Remora Road and Kingsford Smith Drive intersection will be relocated during June and July as part of the intersection upgrade.

Due to traffic restrictions, much of this work will be carried out at night between 7pm and 5am, Sunday to Thursday.

Construction hours

Construction activities take place from 7am-6pm, Monday to Friday from 8am-5pm on Saturday. There will also be work on selected Sundays.

Due to traffic permit requirements, some work must take place at night **between 7pm and 5am, Sunday to Thursday**.

Wherever possible, the noisiest works will be completed early in the shift to minimise impacts on the community.

Work on Sunday

Lendlease will continue to undertake construction activities to install new underground services between 7am Sunday and 5am Monday over a number of consecutive weekends during June and July 2017.

The additional Sunday shifts will reduce the impact of night work on local residents by allowing the project team to complete construction activities during the day that would otherwise need to be carried out at night.

During this work, traffic control will be in place on Kingsford Smith Drive and local roads as required, with one lane open to traffic in each direction. Access to local streets and properties will be maintained with traffic controllers at all times.

In preparation for these works, some temporary service outages may be required. Impacted properties will be notified of any service outage prior to works commencing.

In the event of wet weather these works will be postponed to the next available date.
