

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Project construction update

May 2017

During May 2017, construction activities for the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade will continue to include both land and marine-based activities.

Land-based activities between Amy Street and Theodore Street will include:

- street light and traffic signal work
- road widening and drainage activities on Cooksley and Yulestar Streets
- service location and installation works
- major earthworks and drainage installation
- pavement construction
- asphalt works and line marking
- relocation of concrete traffic barriers.

Marine-based construction activities will include:

- installation of scour protection mattresses
- excavation of the existing river bank retaining wall
- ground improvement works
- piling for the new river walk structure
- production and installation of precast concrete segments that will be used in the river walk structure
- concrete truck deliveries to Bretts Wharf and Cameron Rocks Reserve
- construction of the main retaining wall structure.

What to expect

Work will involve:

- use of construction equipment including excavators, trucks, compaction equipment, road saws, vacuum excavators, concrete trucks, small cranes, barges, piling rigs, pumps and lighting towers
- noise associated with the use of construction equipment
- increased light and heavy vehicle movements associated with construction activities
- vehicles and equipment with flashing lights and white noise (non-tonal) reversing beepers for the safety of onsite workers
- changed traffic conditions including lane, footpath and parking closures, as required
- traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required
- regular barge movements across the river.

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Service installation – Seymour Road

From mid-May 2017, installation of new gas pipes will begin beneath Kingsford Smith Drive and continue along Seymour Road into Allen Street.

The majority of this work will take place during standard hours from 7am-6pm Monday to Friday and from 8am-5pm on Saturday. These works will take up to two months, weather permitting.

During this work, temporary road closures on Allen Street and Seymour Road will be required. Local businesses, residents and motorists will be notified via additional signs and notices prior to any road closures.

Pedestrian access will be maintained through the work site and driveway access will be maintained at all times under the direction of traffic control officers.

Permanent closure – Right turn into Amy Street

From 16 May 2017, the right turn into Amy Street, Albion from Kingsford Smith Drive will permanently close. Access to Amy Street will be available via Cooksley Street and Yulestar Street.

The removal of the right turn into Amy Street allows for the reconfiguration of the intersection of Kingsford Smith Drive and Amy Street to provide two through lanes from Amy Street to Breakfast Creek Road.

Due to traffic permit restrictions, work to implement this traffic change will take place at night, from 8pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday nights. The work will involve changes to the existing traffic signals, removal of the existing median, profiling and asphalt works. This work is expected to take approximately four weeks, weather permitting.

Work on Sunday

Lendlease will continue to undertake construction activities to install new underground services between 7am Sunday and 5am Monday over a number of consecutive weekends during May and June 2017.

The additional Sunday shifts will reduce the impact of night work on local residents by allowing the project team to complete construction activities during the day that would otherwise need to be carried out at night.

During this work, traffic control will be in place on Kingsford Smith Drive and local roads as required, with one lane open to traffic in each direction. Access to local streets and properties will be maintained with traffic controllers at all times.

In preparation for these works, some temporary service outages may be required. Impacted properties will be notified of any service outage prior to works commencing.

In the event of wet weather these works will be postponed to the next available date.
