

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Project construction update

October 2019

Major construction activities will continue on the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade during October 2019.

Construction activities between Amy Street and Harbour Road will include:

- street light work and traffic signal changes
- investigation and installation of utility services
- major earthworks
- drainage activities
- pavement construction, asphalt works and line marking
- footpath, kerb and driveway construction
- ground improvement works
- landscaping activities
- installation of new public pontoon on the Brisbane River, adjacent to Riverview Terrace.

Work will involve:

- use of construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, road saws, vacuum excavators, concrete trucks, cranes, pumps, barges, asphalt and compaction equipment
- noise and light associated with the use of construction equipment
- changed traffic conditions including lane, footpath and parking closures with traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required
- night work and Sunday work as required

Upcoming major traffic changes

In mid-October and early November major traffic changes will be implemented on Kingsford Smith Drive between Toorak Road and Seymour Road as works progress to the next stage of construction, within the centre median. These traffic changes may occur outside of normal construction hours and the local community will receive further information about these works closer to the dates.

Toorak Road to Racecourse Road

In early November, inbound traffic will be realigned onto the newly constructed southern lanes, adjacent to the Lores Bonney Riverwalk, between Toorak Road and Racecourse Road.


Outbound traffic will remain on the existing northern lanes, with a new works area opening in the centre median. Traffic will be in this alignment until early 2020.



Racecourse Road to Seymour Road

In mid-October, outbound traffic between Racecourse Road and Seymour Road will be realigned onto the newly constructed northern lanes, creating a works zone between the inbound and outbound lanes to finalise the centre median.

The completion of the centre median is the final works in this location and will be completed in early 2020.



Major weekend works

To enable pavement construction on Kingsford Smith Drive between Breakfast Creek Road and Hunt Street and reduce the impact and duration of ongoing night work on local residents, the project team will undertake construction of the new pavement over two weekends in late 2019.

Traffic changes on Kingsford Smith Drive and lane closures at the Cooksley Street intersection will be required on the following weekends (*subject to weather and construction conditions*):

- **7pm Friday 18 October to 5am Monday 21 October 2019**
- **7pm Friday 8 November to 5am Monday 11 November 2019**

During these periods, Kingsford Smith Drive will be reduced to one lane next to the works areas between Breakfast Creek Road and Toorak Road, with two lanes maintained in each direction during peak times on Saturday (10am to 3pm).

Further information about these works and associated traffic changes will be distributed prior to the work periods.

Motorists are encouraged to allow additional travel time and seek alternate routes during these works.
