

# KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

## Project construction update

April 2020

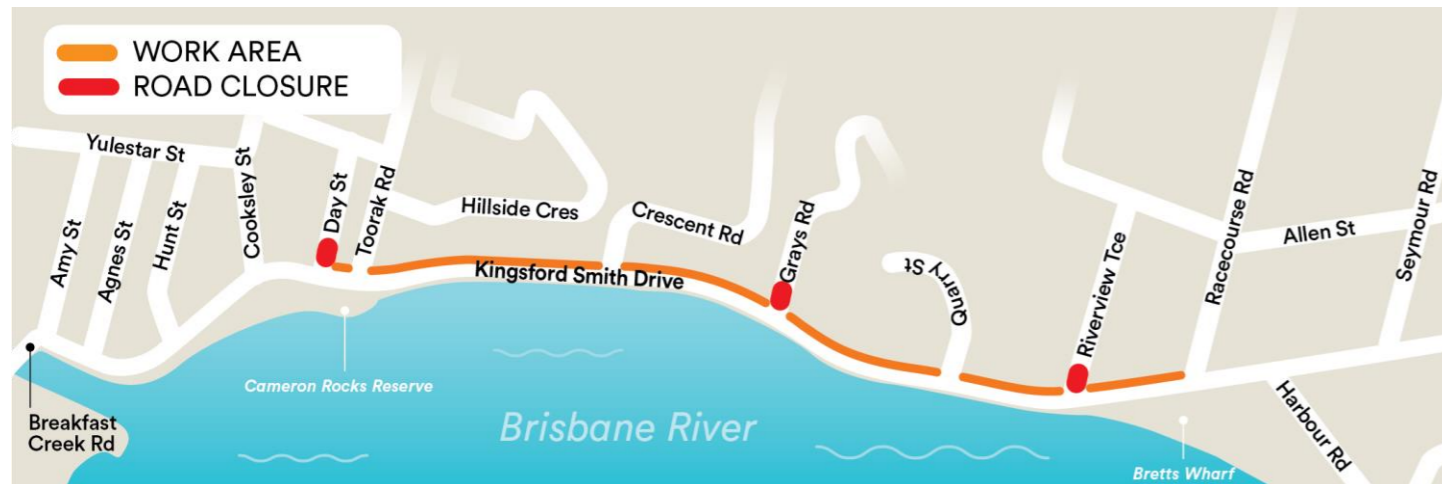
### Major construction activities will continue on the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade during April 2020.

Construction activities between Day Street and Racecourse Road will include:

- installation of new, and upgrade of existing, underground services
- installation of new stormwater infrastructure
- construction of new road foundations
- construction of new asphalt
- construction of new kerb and footpaths
- demolition of old and construction of new driveways
- installation of new street lights
- landscaping
- slope stabilisation works (between Toorak Road and Crescent Road and Grays Road and Quarry Street).

Work will involve:

- use of construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, road saws, vacuum excavators, concrete trucks, cranes, pumps, barges, asphalt and compaction equipment
- noise and light associated with the use of construction equipment
- changed traffic conditions including lane, footpath and parking closures with traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required
- night work and Sunday work as required.

### Major weekend traffic changes – April and May 2020

#### Major weekend traffic changes – Racecourse Road

To enable pavement construction at the Racecourse Road and Kingsford Smith Drive intersection, major construction activities and traffic changes are required.

To reduce the impact and duration of construction activities on local businesses and residents, these major construction activities will require changed traffic conditions and lane closures on Kingsford Smith Drive, as well as at the Racecourse Road and Kingsford Smith Drive intersection:

- **From 7pm Friday 17 April to 5am Monday 20 April 2020 a full closure of Racecourse Road at the Kingsford Smith Drive intersection will be in place.**
- **From 7pm Friday 8 May to 5am Monday 11 May 2020 the right (city bound) turn out of Racecourse Road onto Kingsford Smith Drive will be closed. The left turn into and out of Racecourse Road at Kingsford Smith Drive will remain open.**

**Some delays are expected and motorists are encouraged to allow additional travel time or seek alternate routes, where possible.**

During these weekend works, lane reductions will be in place on Kingsford Smith Drive between Quarry Street and Northshore Way, and the pedestrian crossing across Kingsford Smith Drive at Racecourse Road will be closed.

Detours will be in place on Racecourse Road and Kingsford Smith Drive for motorists and pedestrians.

#### Property and business access

Access out of the Hamilton Hotel, Australia Post and the 7-Eleven onto Racecourse Road will be maintained throughout construction.

Business and property access adjacent to the work area on Kingsford Smith Drive and Racecourse Road will be maintained at all times, under the direction of traffic control if required.

#### What can I expect during the weekend works?

- Works will be completed 24 hours a day, from 7pm Friday to 5am Monday, when traffic volumes on Kingsford Smith Drive and Racecourse Road are lower.
- Construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, compaction equipment, road saws, vacuum excavators, small cranes and asphalt equipment.
- Noise and lights associated with the use of construction equipment, including vehicles and equipment with flashing lights and white noise (non-tonal) reversing beepers for the safety of onsite workers.
- Temporary bus stop and route changes will be in place. See maps overleaf for temporary bus stop closures and alternative bus stops where regular services can be accessed from.
- Changed traffic conditions, including traffic lane and footpath closures with traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, will be in place as required.

**Temporary bus stop changes – 17 to 20 April**

- Please check signage at bus stops
- All outbound bus stops closed on Racecourse Road except for Racecourse Rd/Beatrice St
- All inbound bus stops closed on Racecourse Road – alternative stops on Lancaster Road (stop 24/12) and at Bretts Wharf (stop 19)

- Closed area
- Racecourse Road northbound traffic detour
- Racecourse Road southbound traffic detour
- - - Pedestrian detours
-  Bus stop open
-  Bus stop closed

**Temporary bus stop changes – 8 to 11 May**

- Please check signage at bus stops
- All outbound bus stops on Racecourse Road will remain open
- All inbound bus stops on Racecourse Road will be closed, due to the temporary closure of the right turn out of Racecourse Road onto Kingsford Smith Drive – alternative stops on Lancaster Road (stop 24/12) and at Bretts Wharf (stop 19)
