

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Project construction update

October 2020

Major construction activities will continue on the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade during October 2020.

Remaining construction activities on the upgrade will be undertaken between Day Street and Seymour Road, and will include:

- construction of the new centre median, including concrete works
- installation of new street lights and traffic signals
- final asphaltting and line marking activities
- landscaping
- general maintenance.

The majority of works throughout October, will occur between Day Street and Quarry Street, with only minor works occurring between Quarry Street and Seymour Road.

Work will involve:

- use of construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, road saws, vacuum excavators, concrete trucks, cranes, pumps, asphalt and compaction equipment
- noise and light associated with the use of construction equipment
- changed traffic conditions including lane, footpath and parking closures with traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required
- night work and Sunday work as required.

Night works and temporary traffic changes – Day Street to Quarry Street, Hamilton

The Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade is nearing completion, with the project anticipated to be completed before the end of the year.

From **early October 2020 for up to four weeks**, night works will be carried out and there will be temporary traffic changes on Kingsford Smith Drive **between Day Street and Quarry Street**.

These night works will allow the project team to complete construction activities during the final stage of construction east of Day Street. Once these works are complete, Kingsford Smith Drive will open to three lanes of traffic in each direction between Cooksley Street and Theodore Street, Hamilton.

These night works will include:

- commissioning and maintenance of underground services
- installation of street lighting and traffic signals
- removing the concrete barriers in the centre median with a small crane
- cutting vehicle detector loops into the asphalt with road saws
- removing asphalt with a profiler and trucks
- placing the final layer of asphalt with paving machines, trucks and rollers
- planting trees in the centre median using excavators, mobile cranes and trucks
- permanent line marking of the new road alignment.

Residents on Kingsford Smith Drive and local streets may be able to see and hear this work from their property. In addition, asphaltting works can produce a minor chemical odour.

Traffic changes during night works

During these works there will be lane closures on Kingsford Smith Drive between Day Street and Quarry Street, as well as short term closures of some local side streets at Kingsford Smith Drive for one shift between 7pm and 5am.

These works will also involve temporary driveway restrictions for properties with direct access to Kingsford Smith Drive between Day Street and Quarry Street. Impacted properties will be notified directly ahead of these works. Pedestrian access will be maintained through the work site at all times.

These temporary traffic changes will occur from **early October for up to three weeks from 7pm to 5am**.

Traffic will be detoured around the closures with traffic controllers and signage to assist motorists.

In the event of wet weather or unforeseen circumstances, this timeframe may be extended, or the work activities rescheduled to allow them to be completed safely.
