

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

MAJOR WEEKEND WORKS

Friday 15 February – Monday 18 February 2019

Lendlease wish to advise Kingsford Smith Drive will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Riverview Terrace and Seymour Road, and a localised lane closure will be in place on Racecourse Road, from **7pm Friday 15 February to 5am Monday 18 February 2019**.

These lane closures are required to enable service installation and asphaltting works, as well as traffic barrier movements and the installation of new traffic barriers.

While all traffic movements will be maintained on Kingsford Smith Drive and Racecourse Road throughout these works, significant delays are expected and motorists are encouraged to allow additional travel time or seek alternate routes, where possible.

The following changes will be in place for the duration of these works:

- Bus stop 19 at Bretts Wharf will be closed. Regular services can be accessed from Racecourse Road at Allen Street, stop 20.
- The pedestrian crossing at Racecourse Road to Bretts Wharf will be closed. Pedestrians can cross Kingsford Smith Drive at Harbour Road.
- An inbound lane on Racecourse Road will be closed at certain times throughout the works. All traffic movements from Racecourse Road to Kingsford Smith Drive will be maintained.

The Bretts Wharf ferry terminal will remain open and operational during the weekend works with pedestrian access maintained to Bretts Wharf from Harbour Road and the newly opened River Walk.

Access to properties will be maintained through the work site. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to direct all motorists and pedestrians, where required.

Why are these works happening?

The Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade will improve the capacity of the road to meet the future needs of the traffic network on one of Brisbane's busiest roads.

The upgrade involves widening the road from four to six lanes between Theodore Street at Eagle Farm and Cooksley Street at Hamilton. It also includes improvement works between Cooksley Street and Breakfast Creek Road at Albion.


