

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Project construction update

June 2016

From July 2016, construction activities will start to enable the widening of Kingsford Smith Drive.

During this stage of construction, work will include:

- removal of the majority of the existing centre median
- temporary asphalt work
- widening sections of the existing northern footpath between Hunt Street and Quarry Street
- removal of selected trees in accordance with all required approvals
- service location and relocation (water main, Energen, gas, etc.)
- traffic signal work
- closure of Cameron Rocks Reserve and temporary removal of war memorial
- closure of the public pontoon near Bretts Wharf
- closure of access for vehicles to turn into the car park entrance at Bretts Wharf.

These works are expected to continue until September/October 2016. See map overleaf for work locations.

What to expect

Work will involve:

- the use of profilers, pavers, spray seal trucks, excavators, trucks, compaction equipment, road saws, vacuum trucks, line marking trucks, water blasters, small cranes and lighting towers
- vehicles and equipment with flashing lights and white noise (non-tonal) reversing beepers for the safety of onsite workers
- noise associated with the use of construction equipment
- traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists around the work areas, as required.

Construction hours

Due to traffic permit requirements and to ensure the safety of motorists and construction workers, the majority of these works will be required to take place at night **between 8pm and 5am, Sunday to Friday.**

Where traffic impacts are not required, work will take place from 7am-6pm, Monday to Friday and from 8am-1pm on Saturday.

Traffic conditions on Kingsford Smith Drive

During construction, a minimum of two lanes in each direction will remain open to traffic on Kingsford Smith Drive during morning and afternoon peak hours.

Outside of peak times, a minimum of one lane in each direction will remain open.

Site establishment update

From June 2016, the main site office at 605 Kingsford Smith Drive will be operational.

Work to establish site offices and work compounds at Bretts Wharf, Albion Park Racecourse and 240 MacArthur Avenue is continuing.
