

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Project construction update

February 2017

During February 2017, the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade will continue major construction activities, with increased land and marine based works.

Land-based activities between Amy Street and Theodore Street will include:

- street light and traffic signal work
- road widening and drainage activities on Cooksley and Yulestar Streets
- service location and relocation works, including temporary lane and road closures
- major earthworks and drainage installation
- restoration of the war memorial at Cameron Rocks Reserve
- centre median removal.

Marine-based construction activities will include:

- installation of scour protection mattresses
- excavation of the existing river bank retaining wall
- ground improvement works
- piling for the new river walk structure
- production of precast concrete segments that will be used in the river walk structure.

Relocation of services – local traffic impacts

Relocation and installation of underground services including gas, electricity and telecommunications will continue throughout February. This work will take place at a number of locations including:

- Yulestar Street
- Amy Street
- Harbour Road
- Seymour Road
- Nudgee Road
- Remora Road
- Various locations along Kingsford Smith Drive.

During this work, traffic control, including temporary lane and parking closures may be required. Directly adjacent residents and businesses will be notified prior to work starting.

What to expect

Work will involve:

- use of construction equipment including excavators, trucks, compaction equipment, road saws, vacuum excavators, bitumen, concrete trucks, small cranes, barges, piling rigs and lighting towers
- noise associated with the use of construction equipment
- increased light and heavy vehicle movements associated with construction activities
- vehicles and equipment with flashing lights and white noise (non-tonal) reversing beepers for the safety of onsite workers
- changed traffic conditions including lane, footpath and parking closures, as required
- traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required
- reduced speed limits on both Kingsford Smith Drive and the Brisbane River
- increased barge movements across the river.

Update to construction hours

The project team will be working extended construction hours on Saturdays from 11 February 2017.

Construction activities will take place from 8am-5pm on Saturdays. All works will be behind road barriers or on the river, with no impact to traffic on Kingsford Smith Drive.

These hours are in addition to the standard construction hours from 7am-6pm, Monday to Friday.

Due to traffic permit requirements, some work will be required to take place at night **between 8pm and 5am, Sunday to Friday.**

If any out-of-hours work is required, Lendlease will directly notify residents in the vicinity of the works.
