Changed traffic and pedestrians – Harbour Road to Theodore Street, Hamilton

From **Sunday 17 December 2017**, works on the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade between Harbour Road and Theodore Street will start on the northern side of Kingsford Smith Drive and are expected to continue for approximately 18 months.

To accommodate these works, vehicles and pedestrians will be moved onto the newly-constructed southern lanes and footpath. Additional signage will be installed to help motorists and pedestrians navigate through the work area.



Vehicle access to businesses and properties on the northern side of Kingsford Smith Drive will be maintained via a service road with entry and exit points clearly signed.

The northern footpath between Harbour Road and Theodore Street will be available for local and bus stop access only during this stage of construction.

Changes to outbound bus stops

From Sunday 17 December 2017, outbound bus stops 27 (Harbour View), 30 (Oxford Street) and 32 (Alison Street) will be permanently closed.

Stop 28 (Seymour Road), stop 29 (Remora Road) and stop 31 (College Street) will be temporarily relocated adjacent to the construction area. Pedestrian access to bus stops will be maintained through the construction area and will be clearly signed.

Changed traffic conditions on Alison Street and Oxford Street, Hamilton

From Sunday 17 December 2017 for up to six months, the right turn into Alison Street from Kingsford Smith Drive will be closed. During this closure, a temporary right turn from Kingsford Smith Drive into College Street will be opened.

Access from Alison Street onto Kingsford Smith Drive will be maintained.

Pedestrian access will be maintained around the worksite under the direction of traffic control, and driveway access will be maintained at all times. Additional signage will be installed to help motorists and pedestrians navigate around the area.

This closure is required to allow for the installation of stormwater infrastructure and new underground services. In the event of wet weather or unforeseen circumstances, this closure may be extended to allow the activity to be completed safely.

The Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade will improve the capacity of the road to meet the future needs of the traffic network on one of Brisbane's busiest roads.

The upgrade involves widening the road from four to six lanes between Theodore Street at Eagle Farm and Cooksley Street at Hamilton. It also includes improvement works between Cooksley Street and Breakfast Creek Road at Albion.
