

# KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

## Project construction update

January 2018

### Major construction activities will continue on the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade during January 2018.

Land-based activities between Amy Street and Theodore Street will include:

- street light and traffic signal work
- drainage activities
- investigation and installation of underground services
- major earthworks
- pavement construction, asphalt works and line marking
- footpath construction and landscaping
- relocation of concrete traffic barriers
- ground improvement works
- selected tree removal in accordance with all required approvals.

Marine-based construction activities will include:

- ground improvement works
- piling for the new river walk and drainage structures
- production and installation of precast concrete segments that will be used in the river walk structure
- concrete pours for the main river walk structure
- concrete truck deliveries to Bretts Wharf and Cameron Rocks Reserve.

Work will involve:

- use of construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, compaction equipment, road saws, vacuum excavators, concrete trucks, cranes, barges, piling rigs and pumps
- noise associated with the use of construction equipment
- light associated with the use of temporary lighting towers
- vehicles and equipment with flashing lights and white noise (non-tonal) reversing beepers for the safety of onsite workers
- changed traffic conditions including lane, footpath and parking closures and traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required
- barge movements across the river
- night work and Sunday work as required.

### Why are these works happening?

The Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade will improve the road capacity to meet the future needs of the traffic network on one of Brisbane's busiest roads. The upgrade involves widening the road from four to six lanes between Theodore Street at Eagle Farm and Cooksley Street at Hamilton and improvement works between Cooksley Street and Breakfast Creek Road at Albion.

## Upcoming traffic changes, early 2018

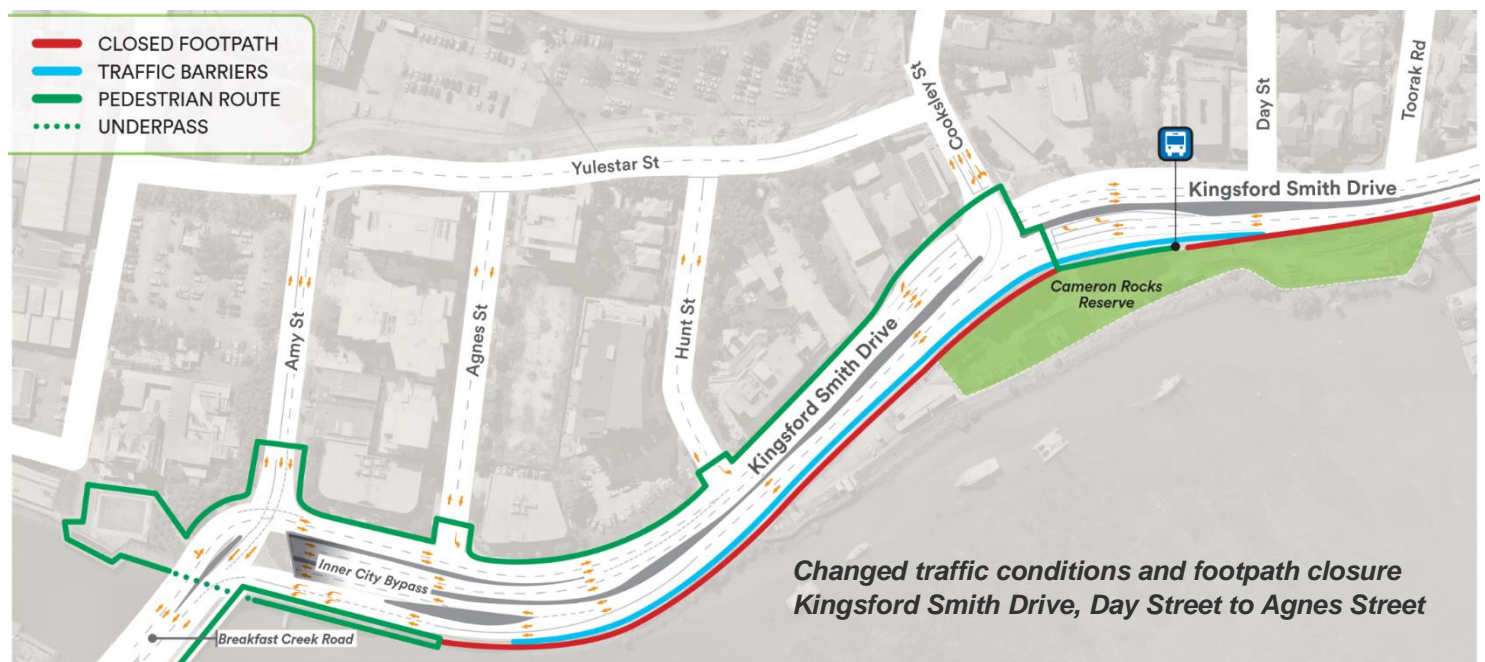
### Temporary road closure - Seymour Road, Hamilton

From **Monday 29 January 2018 for up to three months**, Seymour Road will be closed at Kingsford Smith Drive to traffic in both directions, to enable installation of major stormwater infrastructure and construction of the new road. Traffic will be detoured around the closure with additional signage to help motorists and pedestrians navigate around the work area.

### Changed traffic conditions and footpath closure – Kingsford Smith Drive, Day Street to Agnes Street

From **February 2018 for up to 12 months**, inbound traffic on Kingsford Smith Drive between Day Street and Agnes Street will be reduced from three to two lanes and will be moved towards the northern side of Kingsford Smith Drive. Access from Kingsford Smith Drive to both the Inner City Bypass (ICB) and Breakfast Creek Road will remain open, with two lanes exiting to Breakfast Creek Road and one lane exiting to the ICB.

During this period, the shared user path on the southern side of Kingsford Smith Drive between Cooksley Street and Agnes Street will also temporarily close to pedestrians and cyclists. The footpath on the northern side of Kingsford Smith Drive will remain open.



### Northbound lane closure – Cooksley Street, Albion

From **February 2018 for up to two months**, Cooksley Street will be reduced to one lane and closed to northbound traffic between Yulestar Street and York Street to enable major stormwater installation works. Southbound access will be maintained and motorists can continue to use Cooksley Street to access Kingsford Smith Drive during this time. Access between Kingsford Smith Drive and Yulestar Street will also be maintained in both directions via Cooksley Street.

### Weekend works February to March 2018 – lane closures on Kingsford Smith Drive

There will be traffic changes on Kingsford Smith Drive between **7pm Fridays and 5am Mondays on consecutive weekends from early February to early March 2018**.

Traffic may be **reduced to one lane in each direction** for short sections on Kingsford Smith Drive during this time. Traffic delays are expected and motorists are encouraged to seek alternative routes. Access to all properties, including all businesses in the area, will be maintained. *See enclosed Fact Sheet for more detail regarding these works.*
