Weekend lane closure – Kingsford Smith Drive

January 2018

As part of the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade, public utility services are being relocated and where required, replaced, to ensure these services continue to meet the needs of the local community.

From **2pm Saturday 2 February to 5am Monday 5 February 2018**, Kingsford Smith Drive will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Amy Street and Toorak Road to enable a major new water main to be connected to the existing system.

Access to and from the Inner City Bypass (ICB) and Breakfast Creek Road will be maintained. See map overleaf for the works area.

The inbound bus stop on Kingsford Smith Drive at Cooksley Street (stop 14) will remain operational throughout these works. Pedestrian access to the bus stop will be maintained.

Access to local properties will be maintained at all times. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to direct all motorists around the closures.

Localised water outages will be associated with these works. Further information regarding the outages will be provided to affected residents prior to these works commencing.

In the event of wet weather or unforeseen circumstances, this activity may be extended or rescheduled to the next available weekend.

Why are these works happening?

The Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade will improve the capacity of the road to meet the future needs of the traffic network on one of Brisbane's busiest roads.

The upgrade involves widening the road from four to six lanes between Theodore Street at Eagle Farm and Cooksley Street at Hamilton. It also includes improvement works between Cooksley Street and Breakfast Creek Road at Albion.
