

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Community Notice

Site facilities at Bretts Wharf, Hamilton

From Thursday 25 August 2016, Bretts Wharf will be closed to establish a laydown and storage area in preparation for the start of marine construction activities.

This work will include fencing, establishing a hardstand area and delivery of equipment and materials to site.

Site establishment will take four to six weeks to complete. Once established, the laydown and storage area will remain for the duration of construction activities, which are expected to be completed in 2019.

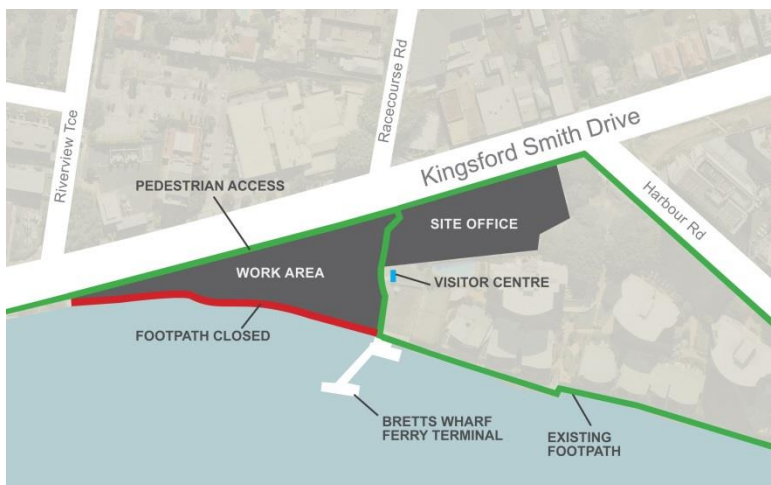
Access to the site will be via Kingsford Smith Drive. Pedestrian and cyclist access to the CityCat will be maintained at all times. Please refer to the map below.

Access for vehicles to turn into the car park entrance at the Bretts Wharf intersection will also permanently close.

Upon completion of the upgrade, this site will be reinstated into an urban plaza and parkland area.

Construction hours

Work will take place from 7am-6pm, Monday to Friday and from 8am-1pm on Saturday. No work is expected to take place on Sundays or public holidays.



Vegetation removal

Some trees will be removed in Bretts Wharf to accommodate the upgraded Kingsford Smith Drive and refurbished park.

Site clearing activities will be undertaken in accordance with all required approvals. Fauna spotter-catchers will conduct pre-clearing surveys and be on site during tree clearing activities.

What to expect during construction

- Use of equipment such as vacuum excavators (sucker truck), excavators, graders, rollers, chainsaws and trucks.
- Removal of selected trees.
- Truck movements to deliver equipment and materials to site.
- Noise associated with use of equipment during construction.

We will make every effort to minimise work impacts by:

- turning off machinery when not in use
- using white noise (non-tonal) reversing beepers on all machinery
- using dust mitigation strategies such as watering down the site as necessary
- ensuring all workforce park in dedicated parking areas and not on local streets
- maintaining access to the **Bretts Wharf ferry terminal**, which **will remain open**.

Construction activities are now complete for the site office at Bretts Wharf. Approximately 25 project team members will move into this office from mid-August.
