

KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

Project construction update

Major construction activities will continue on the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade during March 2019.

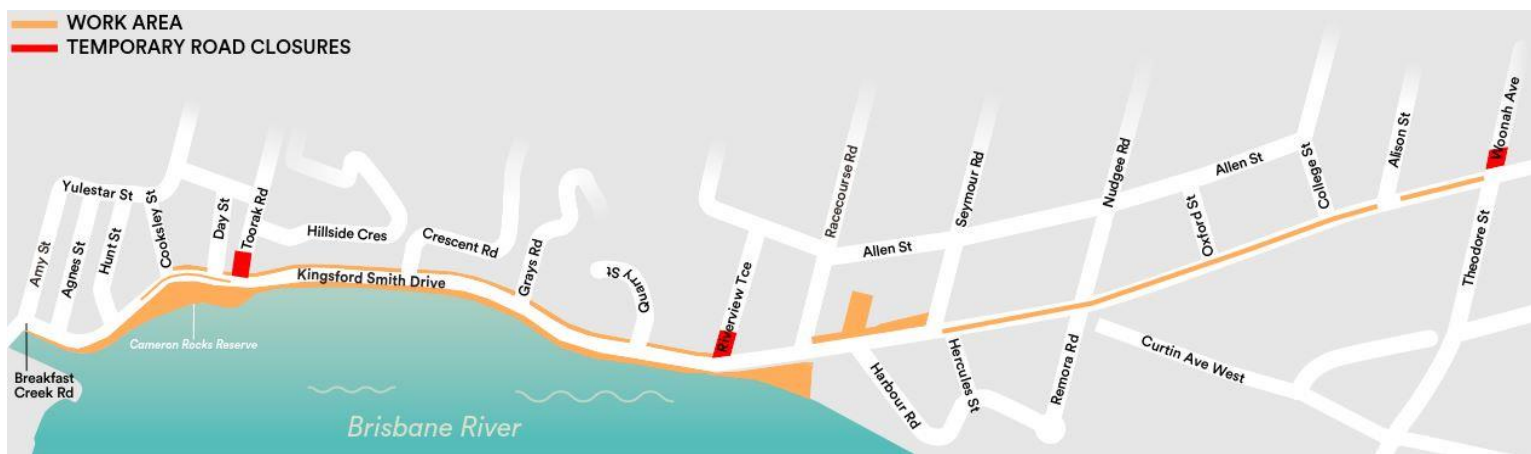
March 2019

Construction activities between Amy Street and Theodore Street will include:

- street light work
- investigation and installation of utility services
- major earthworks
- drainage activities
- pavement construction, asphalt works and line marking
- footpath, kerb and driveway construction
- ground improvement works
- concrete truck deliveries
- landscaping activities
- precast concrete panel installation.

Work will involve:

- use of construction equipment including excavators, trucks, jackhammers, road saws, vacuum excavators, concrete trucks, cranes, pumps and asphalt and compaction equipment
- noise and light associated with the use of construction equipment
- changed traffic conditions including lane, footpath and parking closures with traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists, as required
- night work and Sunday work as required.



Why are these works happening?

The Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade will improve the capacity of the road to meet the future needs of the traffic network on one of Brisbane's busiest roads.

The upgrade involves widening the road from four to six lanes between Theodore Street at Eagle Farm and Cooksley Street at Hamilton. It also includes improvement works between Cooksley Street and Breakfast Creek Road at Albion.

Changed traffic conditions

Agnes Street to Toorak Road

From **early March 2019**, works will begin to upgrade the centre median on Kingsford Smith Drive between Agnes Street and Toorak Road, and are expected to continue for **approximately four months**.

Activities to be completed in the centre median include demolition of the existing median, traffic signal installation, kerb and median installation, pavement works, drainage works and landscaping.

To accommodate this stage, the outbound lanes on Kingsford Smith Drive will be reduced from three lanes to two lanes between Agnes Street and Cooksley Street, with three lanes maintained at the Cooksley Street intersection for outbound motorists (see map below).

Major weekend works

To enable installation of underground services and completion of pavement works, major construction activities across Kingsford Smith Drive are required.

To reduce the impact and duration of ongoing night work on local residents, the project team will complete a number of these activities over weekends in March 2019.

During these periods, traffic changes at the Cooksley Street intersection will be required and Kingsford Smith Drive may be reduced to one lane in each direction in sections.

Further information regarding these works will be distributed prior to the work periods.

Motorists are encouraged to allow additional travel time or seek alternate routes.



Changed pedestrian conditions

Portside Wharf boardwalk, Hamilton

In late February access to Kingsford Smith Drive and the Bretts Wharf ferry terminal from the Portside Wharf boardwalk reopened.

Over the coming months, works will continue adjacent to the River Walk structure and landscaping will start for the new Bretts Wharf Plaza. The new plaza is scheduled for completion in late 2019, weather and site conditions permitting.
