

# KINGSFORD SMITH DRIVE UPGRADE

## Community Notice

### Upcoming road works – Sunday 7 August 2016

August 2016

From **7am to 7pm on Sunday 7 August 2016**, road works and traffic changes will be required on Kingsford Smith Drive to allow for the removal of the existing centre median between Cooksley Street and Riverview Terrace.

The existing centre median is being removed to prepare for widening works on the Kingsford Smith Drive upgrade.

As part of these works, rock breaking activities will be required. In order to minimise noise impacts on the local community, rock breaking activities will take place during the day between 7am and 5pm.

During this work, traffic control will be in place on Kingsford Smith Drive between Cooksley Street and Crescent Road, with one lane open to traffic in each direction. See below map for work areas. Access to local streets and properties will be maintained with traffic controllers at all times.

In the event of wet weather or unforeseen circumstances, this activity will occur on Sunday 14 August.

#### Ongoing night work

Lendlease will continue to undertake night work along Kingsford Smith Drive including other centre median removal activities, service location, asphaltting and line marking.

The majority of works will be completed **at night from 8pm-5am from Sunday to Thursday** to maximise safety for motorists and road workers and to minimise traffic disruptions.

We will make every effort to minimise night work impacts by:

- completing noisier activities early in the shift, when possible
- turning off machinery when not in use
- using white noise reversing beepers on all machinery
- using dust mitigation strategies such as watering down the site.

#### What to expect

- Use of equipment such as concrete saws, excavators with rock breaker attachments, trucks, asphalt profiler and asphalt placement equipment.
- Truck movements to deliver equipment and remove material from site.
- Noise associated with use of construction equipment.
- Vehicles and equipment with flashing lights and white noise (non-tonal) reversing beepers for the safety of onsite workers.
- Traffic control and signage to direct pedestrians, cyclists and motorists around the work areas, as required.

Property access will be maintained at all times. If works require temporary restrictions, access will be maintained under the direction of traffic control.
